To everyone who helped us and patiently watched our progress—Thank You. May we live up to your expectations and our own dreams.

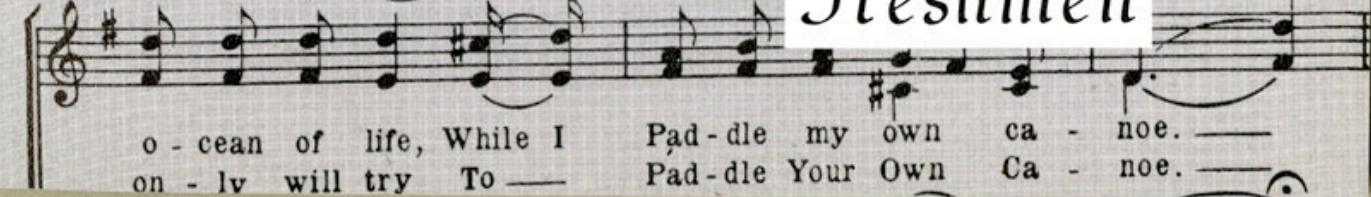
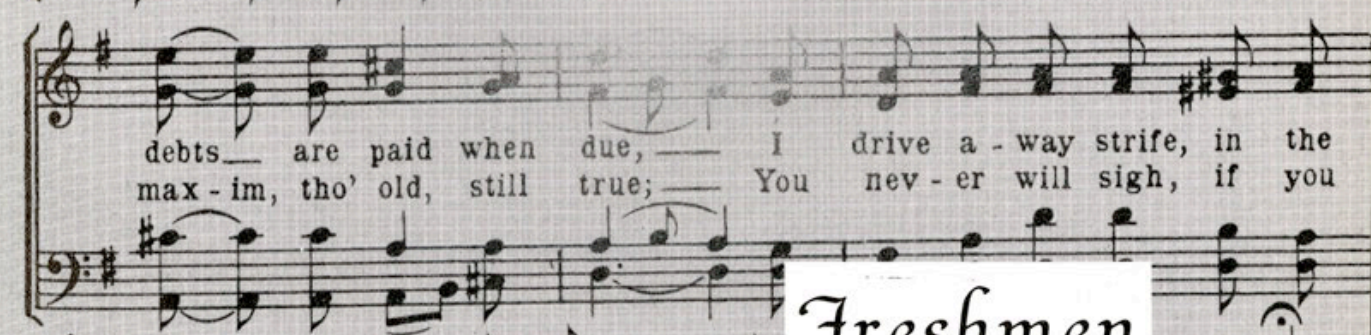
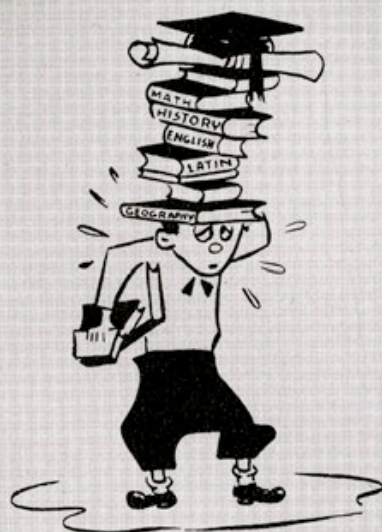
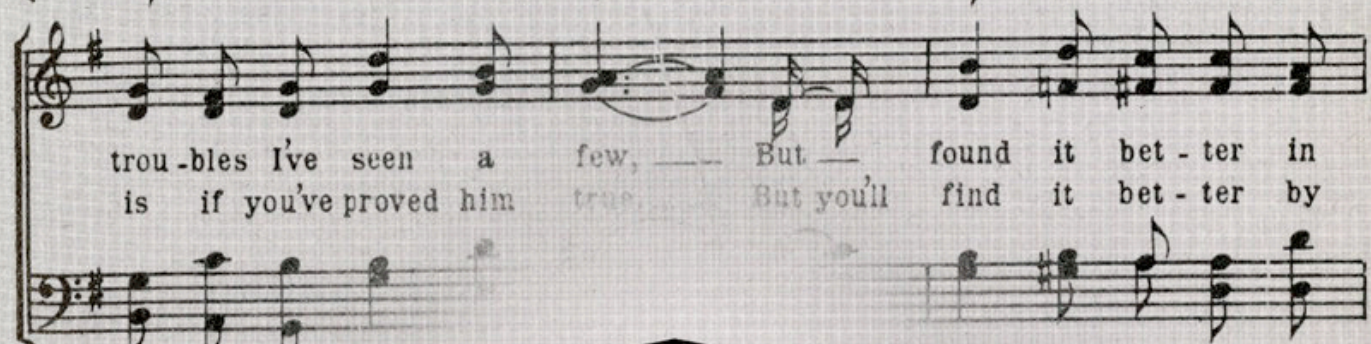
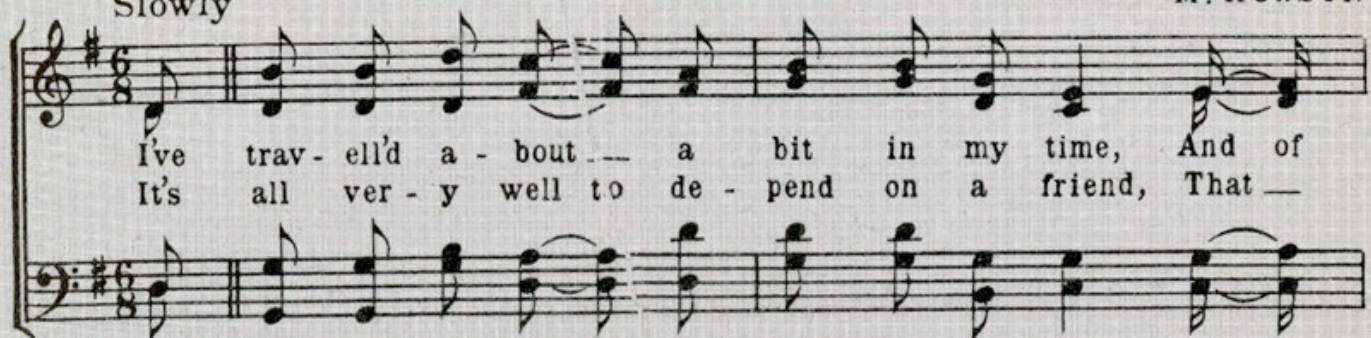
